Hunting Information

- Warm hunting clothing including hat and gloves- make sure to bring several layers as the mornings will be quite cold but the afternoons can be very hot
- Good boots and socks-we suggest comfortable, high top waterproof boots as we may encounter muddy fields and water
- Mosquito repellent-depending on the weather bugs can be a nuisance
- Camera-you do not want to miss any Kodak moments
- **Soft gun case or gun sock**-for easy transport of your shotgun to the field, a hard case is not a problem if you choose not to bring a soft case
- Small backpack or blind bag-for in the field storage of snacks, cameras, and extra gear
- Hearing protection-it is always a good idea to protect your ears during a hunt
- Facemask-The better hidden you are the better your success
- Headlamp-Setting up decoys in the dark is a challenge without a good headlamp.

What to expect:

- Arrive at Saskatoon or Edmonton airport the afternoon before your first hunting day

- Check in at our lodge for introductions, supper, and a brief meeting, which will cover all of the important details of your trip.


